### Staffing

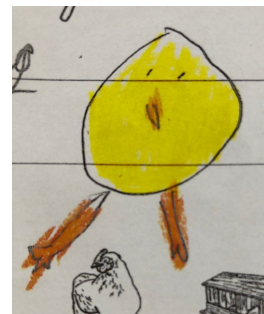

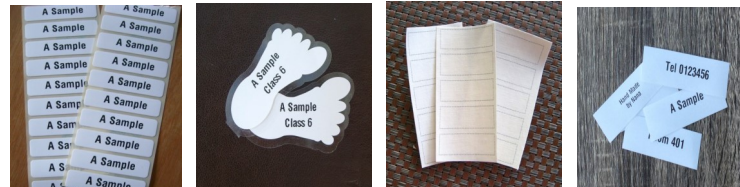
