I am writing to you to inform you of class organisation for the next academic year prior to the our planned end of term transition meets on Google Classroom with new teachers.

The following teachers and teaching assistants will be working in these classes from September 2020.

We are pleased to inform you that Mrs Doganozu will be joining our teaching team from September 2020 and will be working alongside Mrs Moore in Sycamore Class.

We are pleased to welcome back Mrs Cleaver to Acorns to work along the Reception / Year 1 team led by Miss Hardy.

(Acorns and Pine Class will be opened up together to provide a larger provision area for the Reception and Year 1 children as well as the outdoor learning areas. As the year progresses learning for the Year 1's in Pine Class will become more structured to ensure full curriculum coverage.)

(Elm Class will be situated next to Cherry Class where the Library was previously located - there will also be an allocated outdoor space to use during the class day to enable a transition from play based learning to more structured learning to ensure full curriculum coverage.)

Mrs Coventry will be covering Sycamore Class for Mrs Doganozu when she takes her PPA and NQT time.

Teachers planning, preparation and assessment time will be covered by the HLTA staff - Mrs Brown / Mrs Leyssens / Mrs Cleaver and Mrs Broom.

As you may be aware the Year groups at Whitley and Eggborough vary considerably in number across the school with the smallest being 24 and the largest 40 and therefore we are unable to maintain discreet year groups. Please note that we have organised the classes on where we feel the children will be best placed to progress with their learning and self-confidence as well as taking into consideration the class sizes within the school, which are all very similar. Children in all classes will be taught their age appropriate curriculum and challenged accordingly to their needs.

For the majority of children for 2020/2021 they will remain with their existing class groups and move together as a class. The exception for this is for some children moving to Year 6 and for a group of children moving to Year 1. In these instances, I will be writing to parents and carers alongside this letter to share their child's class.

Therefore, if you do not receive an additional letter (including Year 1 and 6) from me please assume that your child will be remaining with their current class and will move to the next teacher as per the list above.

Wherever possible, we try and ensure that throughout the year children in split year groups spend time together studying, playing and on school trips.

We are aware that the year group split can cause concerns for parents and children, however we have endeavoured to make the best decisions for all our children based on suitability of









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provision and need and staffing. Please note that in order to maintain reasonable class sizes for all we will not be moving any children from their allocated class.
