SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES 2021/22

Dear Parent

Read's commitment to offering scholarships to pupils with real talent and potential for excellence is a proud and long standing one.

Scholarships are awarded openly on merit and may be worth up to 25% of the current day fee, dependent on results and funds available at the time. Candidates may sit for more than one award, but the total award will not exceed 25%.

All applicants must be registered with Read, or attending the school, in order to apply for a scholarship. Please note that details of marks and assessments will remain private to the school.

Bursaries may also be available and are offered privately in cases of financial need. They are means-tested and are designed to enable pupils to attend the school who could not otherwise afford to do so. Bursary applications may be made to augment the value of a scholarship. Forms can be requested from the Bursar or Head's PA and should be submitted with the scholarship application form.

11+ Academic Scholarships

Candidates sit papers in English and Maths plus a verbal reasoning test.

11 + Music Scholarships

Candidates will offer one, preferably two, instruments. He or she will need to prepare a short programme featuring all the instruments they are able to play. The standard on the first instrument should be at least Associated Board grade 3, although it is not essential that these examinations have been passed. Some simple sight-reading will be required and some aural exercises.

Candidates are also expected to sit a verbal reasoning test as an indication of general reasoning ability and aptitude, and attend an interview.

11+ Sports Scholarships

Candidates will be required to demonstrate their ability in at least one major sport of their choice, and this must be supported by external evidence.

Candidates are also expected to sit a verbal reasoning test as an indication of general reasoning ability and aptitude, and attend an interview.

Scholarships can be applied for at any time.

The continued award of a scholarship is dependent on the pupil making satisfactory progress as he/she moves up the school. Parents are asked to note that pupils accepted into the Senior School are expected to remain in the school at least until the end of the school year following his/her sixteenth birthday and as long as he/she can profit from the education provided.
